Coast360 Raises \$19,000 for Sustainability Efforts

Maite, Guam – January 9, 2016 – Part of Coast360’s core mission is to be stewards of the environment. Established in September 2015 as the credit union’s charter day celebration, the eCoast Run is a fun event for the community that focuses on sustainability education and support for the island. Coast360 has raised nearly \$19,000 combined from its first and second eCoast Run events. The proceeds are to be used towards sustainability projects around Guam. A total of \$13,000 was donated to non-profit organizations. The remainder of the proceeds is dedicated to a community beautification project that the credit union plans to unveil in March.
